SCIP works with local partners to accelerate EV adoption by incentivizing charging infrastructure, while supporting the state's goals to improve air quality, fight climate change and reduce petroleum use.

Eligible SCIP applicants can apply for rebates up to \$70,000 per DC fast charger for new installation sites or sites with stub-outs. Up to \$40,000 per installation is available for replacement and make-ready sites. In disadvantaged communities, rebates are up to \$80,000 per installation regardless of site type.
